What is the pupil premium grant?

The school receives pupil premium grant funding for each child that is eligible for free school meals. The pupil premium grant is paid directly to the school, and is intended to support pupils who receive free school meals.

Nationally, pupils on free school meals usually make slower progress and achieve less well than pupils who are not on free school meals. The pupil premium grant is aimed at supporting these pupils, and helping them to make more rapid progress, so that they can achieve well at school.
