	Non-renewable energy	A form of energy that can be found on earth, but will run out. For example coal, oil, natural gases and nuclear energy.
	Sustainable	To keep something going or existing.
	Recycle	When you recycle something you put it through a process that allows used things to be reused. For example paper.

-Scientist have seen that there have been some bad environmental changes These include: glaciers and ice sheets getting smaller, non-renewable energy being over used, and deforestation.


## What can we do to change this:

The carbon cycle is a process where carbon dioxide travels from the atmosphere into living organisms and the Earth, then back into the atmosphere. Plants take carbon dioxide from the air along with water and photosynthesis from the sun and use it to make food.
