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Design and Technology

This half term we will be looking at how to make baby bear's chair. The children will try and make the strongest structure using different materials.

Science

Your child will be finding out about animals and humans and what they need to stay alive and be healthy. They will learn about the importance of a healthy diet and exercise.

Physical Education/Outdoor Education

This half term, the children will be doing gymnastics. They will be focusing on warming up and cooling down, stretching, curling and arching.

Computing

Your child will be learning how to log on and off confidently and we will be focusing on online safety this half term.

Mathematics
