Nut free school

This is a reminder that we are a nut free school. This applies to school dinners and packed lunches. We have several children in school with severe nut allergies so please help us to keep all of our children safe by not sending food items which are nuts or contain nuts. Thank you for your support in this matter.

School dinners

We have had a number of children swapping between packed lunches and school dinners. Please note that children may only change between school dinner and packed lunch at the start of every half term.

Recovery from sickness

Whilst it is important that children are in school as much as possible, please remember that if your child has vomited or has diarrhoea, then they must stay of school for 48 hours after that last incident.

Applications for Primary and Secondary Places

Please note that it is now possible to apply for a primary school place. This is done online. Parents must apply even if their child attends our nursery.

The process for applying for a high school place has also opened.

Nursery Places

We have places in our Nursery. Children may start with us in Nursery as soon as they are three. Our nursery is highly staffed and the staff within the unit are experienced and skilled.
